For inpatient coding, the coding professional should assign procedure codes for all procedures that impact reimbursement and quality reporting, and ensure data is captured to meet the organization's needs as designated by the facility guidelines.

The role is responsible for ensuring documentation and coding are to the highest level of specificity, correct codes are assigned, optimal DRGs are identified, and all coding is compliant with coding and regulatory guidelines.

The guidance in the article referring to the 2007 CC re: coding chronic conditions only applies to inpatient, not outpatient. Coding guidelines for reporting chronic conditions is not superseded by whether or not there is a HCC vs a non-HCC and just to get paid.
